Hardscape

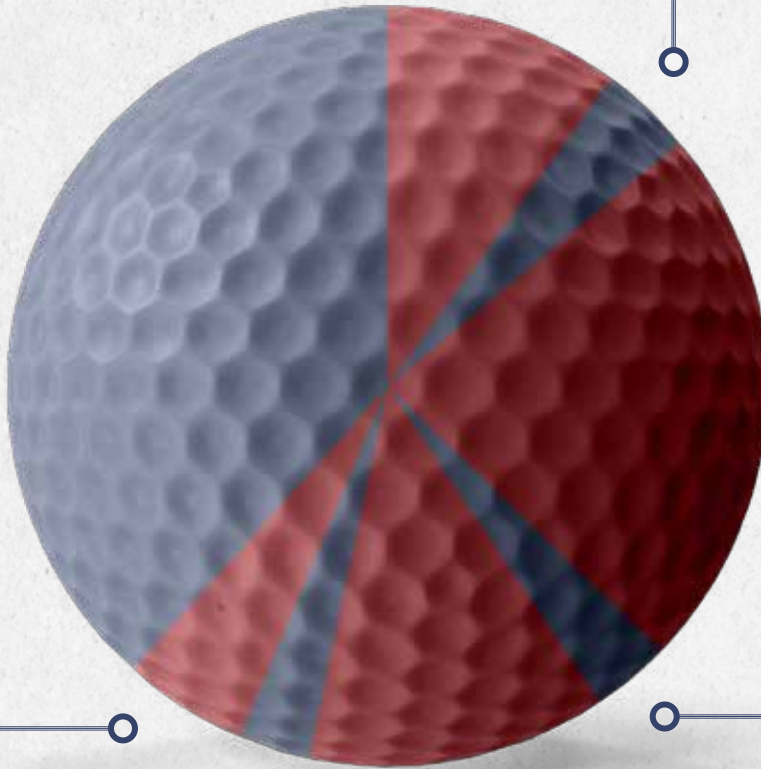
The TGC clubhouse certificate of occupancy depends on building retaining walls and steps and placing boulders that will support the landscape to manage stormwater flow and runoff.
